**British Nursing Index Database Links Package**

The British Nursing Index (BNI) is a bibliographic database that indexes articles from the most popular English language nursing journals published primarily in the UK. BNI also include the RCN Journals archived index of citations, covering over 300 British and English language nursing related journals from 1985 to 1996. BNI is a comprehensive index covering all aspects of nursing, midwifery and community healthcare from 1985 to the present, and is updated monthly.

Ovid now offers enhanced value to the database through the BNI Links Package providing links to FREE Open Access Electronic Full Text and useful links to relevant Internet Resources on the Web.
